Feel confident that you can record your basic ideas.

DAW 2:

In this class, you will build upon everything you learned In the previous classes. Mix productions, mix vocals, build upon creative ideas, and using the DAW as not just a technical tool, but a musical instrument. Further topics that will be covered: mastering for streaming/digital release, basics of music publishing, writing to picture, and more.
